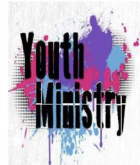

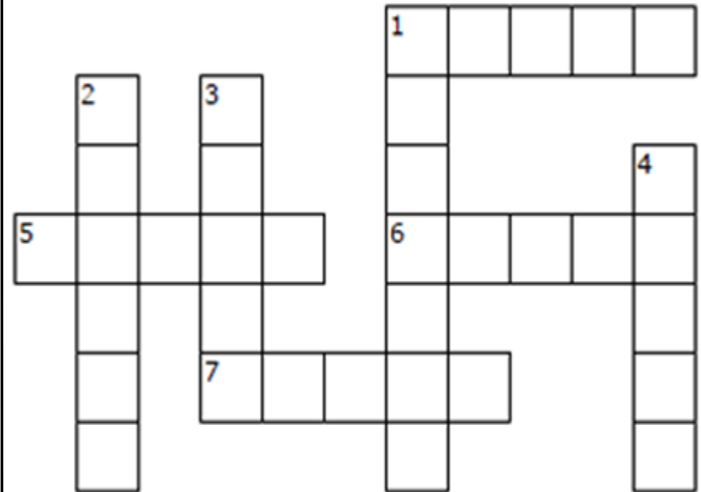
**Youth Ministry / Ministerio Juvenil**

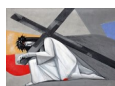
